ENTRIES

Entries will be open from the 1st of March 2022 and will be accepted from female and male players who are members of a recognized Golf Union.

AGE LIMIT: born in 2008 or later **HCP LIMIT:** Girls: 9.4 Boys: 7.4

The player's National Golf Union must certify the exact handicap at the closing date.

LIMITATION OF ENTRIES - 132 PLAYERS: 39 Girls, 84 Boys & 9 Wild Cards (Boys or Girls)

- Girls: 39 players max.
 - > 33 entries will be decided using:
 - The lowest WHS handicaps all Nations taken into account at the closing date
 - > In addition to the limit number of 33 entries:
 - 6 Belgian players selected by RBGF
- Boys: 84 players max.
 - > 72 entries will be decided using:
 - The lowest WHS handicaps all Nations taken into account at the closing date
 - > In addition to the limit number of 72 entries:
 - 12 Belgian players selected by RBGF
- Wildcards 9 max.
 - > 3 Wildcards decided by the Club
 - > 6 Wildcards decided by the RBGF

Stroke play - 54 holes / 18 holes per day - 7-9 July 2022

In the event of a tie for the first place, a hole-by-hole play-off stroke play will be organized until a winner has been decided. The holes that will be used for the play-off are to be decided by the Tournament Committee. All other ties will be decided by matching scorecards (last 36, last 18, last 9, last 6, last 3 and last hole). If this method does not produce an outcome, lot will decide the ties.

NATIONS' - LEAGUES' CUP

Eligible for play of the Nations' – Leagues' Cup are teams of three or four players, who entered the competition before closing date and have been nominated by their National Golf Union either in advance to the RBGF Office or up to the day before the Championship until 3.00 p.m. in the Tournament Office at the Golf Club.

Each country may enter two teams of 4 players (boys or girls or mixed).

54 holes stroke-play teams' event 7-9 July 2022

The aggregate of the three lowest scores from each round will count.

A tie for any place in the Nations' – Leagues' Cup shall be decided using:

- 1. the lowest total of the three lowest scores, one from each day.
- 2. the sum of the three lowest non-counting scores
- 3. the best team score of round 3
- 4. the best team score of round 2
- 5. the best team score of round 1

Any further tie will be decided based on the final stipulated 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole of the best score from each of the tied teams.

CADDIES - ELECTRIC GOLF TROLLEYS

- a) No caddies are permitted
- b) Electric golf trolleys are not permitted.

Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.

For b) Use of any unauthorised form of electric golf trolley shall be discontinued player having a caddie in breach with this Condition must immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred ensure that he conforms to this Condition for the remainder of the stipulated round. Otherwise, the player is disqualified.
