

RULES & CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Amundi Evian Juniors Cup 2022

The tournament will be decided by **stroke play** over **3** rounds of 18 holes each, in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by **R&A** Rules Limited and with the local Rules approved by the **Tournament Committee**. No cut after 2 rounds.

In the event of a tie after 3 rounds (boys and girls categories), the winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off which will take place as soon as the last competitors have completed their final round (Holes 1 / 18 / 1 / 18 / etc). Players finishing with a similar aggregate score after 3 Rounds will be considered as tied.

A Nations' Cup will be played within the tournament as The Amundi Evian Juniors Cup is a Team Event. The three best gross scores of four will count each day. The total aggregate of the 9 scores over the 3 rounds will constitute the team's score.

In the event of a tie, the lowest total of the 3 non-counting scores will win.

If there is a further tie, the lowest total of the 2 worst non-counting scores will win.

If there is a further tie, the lowest score of the worst non-counting scores will win.

A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his/her performance. In this respect, we would like to draw competitors 'attention to the prescribed list of drugs issued by every Sport's Council, a copy which is available on request. Any competitor infringing this Condition, or, if asked to do, refusing to take a test may be disqualified.

Team members are not allowed to smoke on the course.

TEAM ADVISOR

The team Advisor is the person who is wearing the armband given at the Captain's Meeting: he may or may not be a professional golfer (e.g.: the coach...)

Note: The Team Captain, or the coach, can be named as a Team Advisor. Only the Team Advisor may offer advice on the course (the team Advisor is not allowed on the greens). Please refer below for caddying permissions.

If someone else (other than team partner or team advisor) is standing next to a player or giving advices, any infringement to those conditions will be sanctioned by:

- First infringement: Player warning
- Second infringement: 2 strokes penalty
- Third infringement: Disqualification (DSQ)

If advice is given by someone not being team advisor or team partner, the player should take action to stop this irregular procedure.

If he does not do so, please refer to the sanctions up-there.

CADDIES

Only Team Advisor and fellow competitors (team partner) are allowed to caddy.

Team Partners caddying are allowed on the greens.

Team Advisor caddying is not allowed on the greens.

ACCOMPANYING

The people accompanying the players and teams will be allowed to follow the games.

However, they will not be allowed to stay within a talking perimeter from the players. They will not be allowed on the tee areas, greens and fairways.

Any infringement to those conditions will be sanctioned as explained before.

PRIZES

The winner of the tournament in each category (nations, girls, boys) shall be for the period of one year The Amundi Evian Juniors Cup Winner.

- The winner in each category and those finishing second and third will receive Mementos offered by the tournament committee
- The three best teams in the Nation's Cup will receive Mementos offered by the tournament committee
- The Amundi Evian Juniors Cup Trophies will remain at The Evian Resort Golf Club.
