**ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES**

*These local rules complement the Permanent Local Rules for French Federal Amateur tournaments.  
They cancel and replace all previous local rules.*

**OUT of BOUNDS (Rule 18)**

Defined by fences, stone walls (the wall itself is out of bounds), lines and/or stakes, the lines prevail over the stakes.

**ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)**

Immovable Obstructions

- All roads and paths on the course, including those with a non artificial surface;
- The stone walls on the course;
- The house on the left at hole no. 4;
- The pumping area on holes no. 14 and 16 .

No Play Zone

- The newly sown grass nursery at the right on hole no. 2

Free relief **must** be taken from interference, Rule 16.1f.

**ANIMAL DUNG (MLR F-12)**

On holes 6 et 16, at the player's option, dung from geese may be treated either as:

- A loose impediment that may be removed under Rule 15.1 or
- Ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1

**ATTENTION - DOUBLE GREEN (6/17)**

Hole no. 6 = Yellow flag

Hole no. 17 = Blue flag

**PARTICULAR CONDITIONS**

**PACE of PLAY**

Players are invited to play according to the principles of "Ready Golf".

The Committee has established a maximum time to finish the round of **4h30**minutes, not to be exceeded.

If a group exceeds this maximum time, a penalty of 2 strokes will automatically be applied to all players in the group at recording, according to the terms of the permanent local rules of the French Golf Federation.

**REMINDER**

In case of doubt and in the absence of a referee, a player can play a second ball according to Rule 20.1c(3). He must report the facts at recording. The player will be disqualified if he fails to report it.
