

## FRENCH INTERNATIONAL MEN'S MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP - MURAT CUP

30<sup>th</sup> June – 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2023

These specific Local Rules complete the permanent Local Rules published by the French Golf Federation.  
These rules supersede all other local rules.

### Integral Parts of the Course

- All roads and paths, except the road running from the club house to the 8th green
- Graveled area around the club house
- The wooden railway sleepers at the bottom of the fences defining out of bounds
- The wall on the left of hole n°15
- Hole 16, left hand side, materials that are piled will not be removed. The ball must be played as it lies, or declared unplayable.

### Immovable Obstructions – R16.1

- The road running from the club house to the 8th green
- Staked trees = stake / basin / plastic protection

### Out of bounds – R18.1

- Where there are concrete poles in front of the wire mesh fence, the out of bounds is determined by the nearest inside points at ground level of these poles.

### Practice on competition course (cf. Model Local Rule I-1.1)

Rule 5.2a is modified in this way:

- A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds.
- Penalty for Breach of this Local Rule:
  - Penalty for first breach: General Penalty (applied to the player's first hole).
  - Penalty for second breach: Disqualification.

### Modification of the Code of conduct (Rule 1.2) cf. Hard Card 14(a):

**The player must not replace his divots but he must replenish them with the sand (Divot-mix) from the bag given at the start of the round. It will be possible to refill this bag at the tee box of hole 10.**

**Penalties for violation of the code of conduct in stroke play is applied.**

### General information

- Blue and yellow stakes on the course indicate 150 meters middle of the green.
- Toilets and water point in the shelter to the left of the green of hole n°9
