GOLF de BAUGE FRENCH INTERNATIONAL SENIORS 2 21st – 23rd JULY 2023

SPECIFIC LOCAL RULES

These specific local rules cancel and replace any other previous local rules. They complete permanent local rules for french federal amateur tournaments.

OUT OF BOUNDS

• Defined by electric fence on holes 2, 15 and 16.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS

- Roads and paths.
- Rocks piled up on holes 2, 5 and 6.

INMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

• Electric fence defining the penalty area on right part of hole 3.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

- If the ball is lying on gravelled or stoned zone anywhere in the general area (including paths or roads), a free relief is allowed. But interference does not exist for the player's stance.
- Collapsed drains.

POWER LINES AND POLES

• If it is known or virtually certain that the ball hit a power line, the player must replay the stroke from the spot where that stroke was made. If no, they get general penalty. Poles and supports wires are not concerned : a ball hitting them must be played as it lies.

PENALTY AREAS

- If there is no line on the ground, the edge of penalty area is defined by mowing height.
- The penalty areas on holes 3, 4 and 14 (both left and right) are unlimited. The penalty area on left part of hole 15 is unlimited.
- On hole 13, for any ball that is in the river, the player may, in addition to the options available under rule 17.1d, always with a one-stroke penalty, drop a ball in the dropping zone (DZ) in front of the river, which is a relief area under rule 14.3.

PREFERRED LIES

• When any part of a player's ball touches part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relif once by placing the original ball or another one, less than one club length from the original spot.
